

ON MARCH 22-1944 WE LAFT CAMP KILMER AND LOADED AT MEW YORK CITY ON THE DOMINION Ship (MION ARCH) AT - 1-0 Chock FRARCH- 23 we LEFT FOR ENGLAND. PACKED IN The Ship LIKE AN HEARD OF CATTLE WE RODE FOR 13 DAYS - TOKING Shots, HAVING PIRE DRILL AND STANDING INSPECTIONS . SOME TOO SEA SICK to DIE, BUT STIGH HAP TO TOKE IT. CAME OVER ON A BRITISH'S Ship SO WE DIDN'T GET ANY THING WORTH EATING . ON THE AFTER-INCOM OF APTIL-4-44 WE DOCKED AT LIVERPOOL BUT WERE KEPT DOWN IN THE HOLE UNTIL AROUND 5-0'CLOCK - April 5 . The RE WE LOADED ON THEIRS SO CALLED TRAINS AND RODE FOR 5 HOURS. FROM THERE WE got ON TRUCKS OND WENT TO GOR CAMP (KINGET HALL TO BEGIN START OUR TRAINING OVER SEA. THEY SET UP A BN. MESS THERE SO THERE IS WHERE THE COOKS CAUGHT HELL. G- HAND K WOTHED TOGENHER WITH THE CO WHEN WE WERE OFF Shift. ON April 29th Shinehr AND & LEFT to FIRE THE MACHINE-GUN AND HAD A NICE TIME AS THERE WERE A.T.S. GITLS STATIONED THERE . WE GET BACK FOR KINLET HALL ON MAY 3 Id. ON MAY 13 - HA THE COMPLETY LEFT KINLET HALL , DIONT KNOW WHERE THEY WERE GOING. THEY WENT TO THE SID RINCE TRACK WHERE THEY THE 16th AND THEN WE WENT ON OUR KITCHEN TRUCK TO BOURSMOUTH, ENG-WHERE WE MOVED INTO A HOTEL. WHILE WEWERE THERE WE HAD OUR TRAINING - CHINGING ROPES, GOING ON HIKES, PLAYING BALL, AND PULLING GUARD. ON THE 15 OF JUNE WE LEFT BOURSMOUTH. RAND JUNE 16 WE LOADED ON A L.S.T. AND HEADED FOR FRANCE, WE SLEPT DOWN IN THE HOLE The NIGHT OF THE 16 BUT THE 17TH WE MOVED UPON DRCK. WE LANDED THE Night of the 18th. AND got A WELCOME FROM HINTER'S AIR FORCE, WE got OFF ON WITHH BEACH THE MOTNING OF JUNE 19- AT 2-0'Clock . WE WALKED ABOUT TEN MILES BEFORE SETTING ON THE KITCHEN TRUCK AND THEN WE WENT TO A FIELD WITH READ. THERE WE DOG IN AND PULLED GUARD. THERE IS WHERE BREAULT TALKED TO THE BY THE GERMANS.

ON THE 26 OF JUNE WE WERE ALL CALLED TO GEATHER AND TOLD

WE HAD TO go up to BN. AS QUARD AS WERE LOW, ON

MEN. WHEN HE GOT to BN. WE DUG US AN HOLE FOR SHELLS WERE COMING OVER FAST. SCHWERR, PAVALE, AND I STAYED IN ONE HOME FOR IT WAS RAINING AND WE DIDN'T HAVE BUT ONE ShELTER HALF WITH US. THE MOTNING OF THE 27 of GUNE WE WERE CALLED OUT AND WALKED ABOUT 3 MILES UP TO OUR COMPANY. WHERE THEY WERE HOLDING OUT SIDE OF CHERBOURG. I WERE SENT OUT to THE FIRST PLA. AND THERE & FOUND ABOUT FOUR MEN THAT & KNEW. ALL THE OLD COMPANY HAD GOTTON KILLED OF WOUNDED. I DUQ ME & HOLE FAST AS THOSE 88'S CAN MAKE YOU DO SOME FUNNY THINGS. THE WIGHT OF THE 27 & PULLED GUARD ALL NIGHT AS & WERE TOO SCARED TO SLEEP, JUNE THE 28th A TRUED TO SLEEP BUT I STILL COULDN'T ALThough I HAD BEEN UP TWO MIGHTS. THAT AFTER NOON THEY BROUGHT ME DOWN SOME MAIL FROM HOME AND IT SURE DID HELP OUT. THE NIGHT OF THE 28th S-SOT AMBURY SENT INE WITH THREE OTHER MEN OUT ON A LISTENINGPOST, WE LAVED OUT THERE WITH Shaws FALLING AND MACHINE GUNS FIYING OVER OURS HEADS UNTIL 3:30 THE MOTNING OF THE 29 AND THEN WE WENT BACK IN . AROUND MOON THEY SENT FOR ME TO COME to the CO C.P. AND SENT US ALL BACK TO THE KITCHEN. THE WIGHT OF THE 29 OF THE JUNE WE SET UP OUR KITCHEN to cook our FIRST MEAL FOR OUR BOYS SINCE MAY the 13th. WE DIDN'T GET ANYTHING BUT 10-1 RATIONS TO COOK FOR THEN BUT ANYTHING HOT WAS BETTER THAN K- RATION. WE COOKED For them JUNE THE 30TH. AND JULY TO FIST. SURE DIDN'T HOOK LIKE K- CO FOR NEARLY ALL THE OLD MEN WERE GONE. AFTER SUPPER OURS BOYS PULLED OUT AGAIN, HOPING TO SEE THE KITCHEN SOON - WHICH SOME IVEYER DID . WE LOADED UP AND PULLED OVER INTO ANOTHER FIELD FOR THE NIGHT. ON JULY -2-44 EYERY BODY WERE TO GO UPON THE LINES EXCEPT INESS SOT, I FIRST COOK, AND ONE SECOND COOK, WE BYAWED CARDS SO MIYENS AND & got to STAY BEHIND. THERE FORE

BREAULT, PAYLIC, AND SCHWERR HAD TO go Up. The 3rd of guly WE MOVED ONER BACK WITH THE REST. WHERE WE HAD TO PULLED BURRO FOR THE PERSONNEL ON THE NIGHT OF THE STO. GIVEN AND & DULLED GUARD ON A POST NEAR THE KITCHEN. ON THE 4TH OF JULY GIVEN HAD TO GO UP TO PERSONMELTO PULL GUARD UP THERE. JULY STA WEWERE CALLED OUT AGAIN to help ON THE LINE - JUST LEAVING ONE MAN TO WITH THE KITCHEN. ON THE WAY UP WE GOT POUGHT UNDER ARTILLERY BE FIRE AND DIDN'T HAVE ANY HOLES TO GET IN. GoING UP WE WADED Through MUD UP to OURS KNEES. SIVENS AND & FOUND US AN HOLE AND & PULLED GUARD ALL MIGHT ON THE ARCOUNT OF BIVENS WAS SIEK. ON July 9th ON OUP LEFT FLANK THREE GERMANS TRIER TO GET THROUgh OUT LINES. THEY GOT ONE , BUT HET TWO GET AWAY SO AROUND NOON THEY LAIDED THE SHELLS IN ON US. WE LOST 17 MEN THE 5 DAYS WE WERE UP THERE. ON THE 13 OF JULY WE WENT BACK TO THE KITCHEN FIND DYEAUIT, POULIE, AND SCHWEAR CAM IN RIGHT AFTER WE DID. ON JULY-11th CAPT ALLEN GOT KILLED FIGHTING FOR HIZE 122. CARTER GOT WOUNDED AND WEST GOT KILLED " JULY 1574 WE DYAWED . NEAR ST-20 B- RATION AND WENT UP AND DUG OUT KITCHEN IN TO BOOK FOR THE COMPANY. JULY 16 WE FED THE MIEN AND THEM THEY MOVED OUT MANN. TO FINE WE JUST HAD O MERY FEW OLD MEN. MY BEST BUDDY (CLELL CAPTER) WAS THERE NO LONGER TO go Through the Chow LINE - AND LT. LOWE A FINE MAN HAD TAKING OVER COMMIAND OF THE COMPANY AFTER CAPT ALLENS DEATH. THE COMPANY PULLED OUT AGAIN JULY - 24 HEADED FOR PERRIERS. ON JULY 28 WE MOVED INTO FIELD NEAR ST. SAUYEUR to BE WITH THE COMPANY FOR A FEW MORE DAYS. THERE SINCE THE BOYS WERE OUT OF RAIVOR OF SHEATS THEY MADE THEM GO ON HIKES AND GAVE THEM CLOSE-OFDER PTING.

ON Aug th. 1st. we were ThE CO. MOVED OUT AGRIA BUNNING THE GERMANS NOW. ON AUG WE MOVED OUT AND WENT MEDR GRATHEY WENT THROUGH LANDING AND ERNEE WITH TASK FORCE WEAVER IN LEED. ON AUG 6 THE 3rd. BN. KITCHENS MOVED OUT LEAVING US UNTIL THEY COULD SEND BACK AFTER US AS OUT STRUCK WAS OFF HAULING SUPPLIES. JUST BEFORE DARK M-COMPANY Truck CAME BACK AFTER US - SO WE LOADED UP AND PULLED OUT FOR THE 18 MILES MIDE. GERMAN'S PLANES WERE TRYING TO BOMB A BriDGE AT GRANVILLE. WE GOT LOST AND HAD to publi INTO A HAY-FIELD FOR THE NIGHT. AUG-7 WE WENT ON TO THE FIELD TRAIN WHERE THE OTHER KITCHEM WERE. ON AUG THE 9th WE MOVED OUT WITH WITH FIEHD TRAIN FOR A LONG PIDE, WE MOVED 0 60 MILES AND UNLOADED OUTS ON A HILL ABOUT 2 MILES FROM LE MANS DYEAULT AND & WENT TO A FYENCHMAN'S HOUSE to GET SOME Eggs AND SHE THIS US THE GERMANS LEFT THERE THE NIGHT BEFORE. AUG THE 11Th. WE MOVED Through LE-MAINS AND IN A FIELD WITH THE 357Th BEAT. KitchElys. Aug- 14th SCHWELLY AND PAYLIE WENT UP to the LINE, AUG 16 WE WOVED UP AGAIN AND SEWELT AND PAVLIE CAME BACK AS WE WERE COOKING AND SENDING Chow up to the MEN AS THEY WERE HOLDING AROUND THE GREAT FAHAISE POCKET (KNOWNED BETTER TO DUPS BOYS AS DEALTH VALLEY WHERE THEY HAD THE SS PANZER DIVISION TRAPED. ON AUQ. 21 WE MOVED UP OUT FROM SEES WITH THE CO. FOR ThEY HAD BEEN RELIEVED, On AUQ 260 WE MOVED OUT WITH THE CO FOR AINOTHER LONG RIDE. WE PULLED INTO A FIELD AND UNLOADED AND LIND AND I ANGENER HITCHEN Moved into the woods after dark and set up the ketchen to cook

bunksfast for the to. We tooked for them Avo 27 + 28 then they moved out on 3rd Army trucks. We stayed their until and went up and saw one of their camps. The night of the 27th leve moved up about 10 miles to a field and unloaded. ON the 28 of Aug. Joe and & went with Lind to have troops. We went through thateau - I bierry the town they had their big fight in in world was # 1 . We went back Aug 30 and got the ketchers and brought them up into the odd world war #1 battle ground and unloaded in the woods . He tooked for the Trages and sent chow up on a jup where they are my I the Bring Bridge book on Sept 2 we moved through Reins and put up in the woods just afet. side of town with the to for awhile. We were out of Gas and Couldn't go any further. He were they until Sept 7 and then pulled out with the to. leaving them in a field. That might we had to unload and go back and get another ketchen of the 2 Bn . Sept 8th we moved up to the to again and fed them the 9th of Sept, them spelling out the 10 of Sept. We moved into a old saw mill the 10th of sept the first whether we had since we landed in France.

Sept - 12 - Hy we knowed out and moved into a lave with a high rock wall all around up us. We moved out on Sept 15 and went through Home court and going and and unloaded in the woods. We set up there Cooking for the to while they were on a hill outside of Truty. He had all kinds of pretty French and from good and Home court loning out to see who We stayed there until the 30th of dept and then we moved over about to miles from going where we tould get a few in Coming whell . We dig us some holes and put a good top on then and had a new little lay-out. Goe and I went to ground on act 9th and took a showel and Looked over town and he will of soft and moved to marginer LES METZ in an ald factory with the other 3rd Bur butchen, We were there until The IHOF OUT WHEN WE MIONED to PUMBUS TO FEED THE CO FOR A DAYS IN A Big School HOUSE. AFTER THE CO PULLED OUT ON THE 19 OF OCT WE WENT BACK TO TOPALZIERES IN THE SAME OLD FACTORY. On The 25. OF GET WE LEFT TOPIZIERES and WENT BACK ON A BREAK, THERE WE HAD A NIER ROOM FOR THE KITCHEN BUT FOR DURS DEDS WE to Took OVER FROM THE COWS. ON THE NIGHT of YOU THE 9th WE LEFT AGRIN. WE RODE ALL WIGHT AND UNLOADED THE 10TH AND COOKED SUPPER AND SENT IT UP TO THE MEN, THAT WIGHT WE HERE SENT UP AGRIN AS CARRYING PARTIES ON THE CROSSING OF THE MOSETHER RIVER.

ON NOV- 12 WE CROSSED THE MOSELLE WADING WATER WARS DEAP IN WATER AND THEN CARRING K-RATIONS FIVE MILLES ON THE OTHER SIDE, WE THEN EROSSED BACK OVER - EARLY THE MOTIVING OF THE 13. THE AFTER MOON OF THE 13th WE WENT BACK CROSS THE MOSELLE to EARRY BATIONS UP to the LINE. ON THE 16 OF NOV. WE EAME BACK to THE KITCHEM. WE FOUND THE BEET. HITCHENS IN ONE BIQ BLDQ - THERE WE GOT CLEAN CLOTHS. ON THE 19TH OF NOV. & WENT UP TO THE CO. TO HELP SIVENS & BREAULT COOK FOR THE CO. THE 20 of NOV. WE MOLED TO THE WEAT FOUN ON THE JEEP AND THERE THEY BROUGHT THE HITCHEN UP. THE 33 NO WE MOVED OUT AND MOVED INTO THE WOODS AND COOKED SUPPER WAEN ORDER CAME DOWN FOR US TO LOAD UP AND WE MOVED INTO A-TOWN 2 KIL FROM Ser. WE FED SUPPER AND PUT OUR TRUCK INTO A BARK AND CODKED BREAKTAST THE 24Th. I THE CO PULLED OUT THE MOVING OF THE 24th. TAKING BREAULT AND PAULIC WITH THEM TO MAKE COFFEE. ON THE 29 OF NOV WE MOVED THE KITCHEN UP AND GOT SHEALED GOING THUR FUR WATER, MER, NOW WE WERE IN SER SO WE COULD TAKE WHAT WE WANTED. THE 30th OF NOV THE EO CAME BARK AND WE MOVED TO SEIRBURG, YER WHERE WE WRECKED A HOUSE AND SET THE KITCHEN UP. LIPARI GOT A PASS TO PARIS WHILE WE WERE THERE, ON DEC. 4th WE WERE ALL CALLED TO. QEATHER AND TOLD WE WOULD BE USED FOR PARRYING PARTIES ON THE SAAR RIVER CRUSSING WE LEFT BEFORE DAYLIGHT THE OF THES BUT DIDN'T MORNING QET TO CROSS MORNING OF THE 6 ON AND WACKINE FIRE . ACCOUNT OF ShallING

WHEN WE GOT SYER THERE CROSS WE WERE TOLD TO GO DOWN THE RIVER UNTIL WE HIT THE RAIL ROFF AND THEN TAKE DOWN IT UNTIL WE CAME TO ANOTHER BAIL ROAD AND THEN LOOK FOR AN WATER TANK. THAT WAS PACKIEN-COLONY, SER WHERE THE BRD BN C.P. AT. WHEN WE GOT THERE WE WERE WET ALL OVER AND TOO TIRED TO MOVED AFTER CARRYING 5 NOUND OF 81 M.M. MORTOR WE DIDN'T HAVE ANY BLANKETS SO WE MADE AN FIRE AND TRIED TO GET DRY, THE 6 WE MOVED INTO A CELLER WHERE WE LAIED AROUND LIKE HOOS IN THE SAND - WE WOULD MAKE 2 AND 3 TRIPS AN MIGHT DOWN TO THE RIVER AND THEN IN WE CARRIED UP TO THE LINES AND WOULD BRING LITTERS CASES BACK. WE COULDN'T DULL OUR ShOES OFF FOR IF WE DID WE COULDN'T GET THEN BACK ON. ON THE MOTHING OF THE 9th WE WERE BRINGING All LITTER CASE BACK WAEN BREAULT GOT HIT. WE WENT ABOUT 75 YARDS WAEN ANOTHER FELLOW GOT HIT SO THEN SIVENS CANE BACK TO HELP ON MIY LITTER THE NIGHT OF THE 12TH WE TOLD THEM WE COULDN'T CARRY ANY MORE FOR 6 days WITH OUT ANY SLEED HAD GOTTON THE BEST OF US. THE NIGHT OF THE BOF DEC. WE LEFT TO GO BACK TO THE KITCHEN. WHEN WE GOT EROSSED THE RIVER AND READY TO GET OF THE BOAT THEY LAID TWO SHEELS IN WHICH LONG FROM M-CO GOT HIT. WE THEN WENT ON TO THE IN SEIRBURG, WE LAIDED AROUND IN The 20th OF DEC. WHEN WE PULLED FOY A BREAK, ON THE LOAD SCHWEAR, HARDY AND ALONG. TO RIDE FINE SOME WHERE TO

SET UP THE KITCHEN. WE WERE ALL COLD SO WE GOT IN THE FIRST BARN WE COULD FINE . AFTER WE UN-LOADED LIPARI WENT BACK AFTER THE OTHER PART OF THE HITCHEN . WE CHEANED OUT THE BARN AND THEN HARDY WENT TO FINE US SOME WHERE TO SLEED. THE 21 NO DEC. THE CO. PULLED IN FOR A LITTLE BEST AFTER SPENDING THEIR TIME IN HELL THE MOTIVING OF THE 23 rid & went BREK TO THE REST CAMP FOR TWO DAYS WHICH WAS ON + CRUSS THE MOSELLE RIVER. THE 25 th & got BACK TO FINE SIVENS GONE TO THE REST PAMP AND THEK WERE COOKING CHRISTMAS DINNER, WE HAD A WHITE Christ MAS AND SPENT OUR NEW KEAR IN ALGREEN ON GANGE-1945 WE PULLED OUT WITH THE CO. AND THE ROADS WERE SO BAD WE GOT LOST IN LUX CITY FROM THE CONVOY, WE FOUND THEM JUST BEFORE WE got WILKE WE WELL GOING, SNOW GETTING DEEDER ALL THE TIME, ON THE MOTHING OF THE 7th WE UNLOAD ED AND COOKED FOR THE CO. THEY MOVED OUT THEN COIND TO THE NEST TOWN. THE ROADS WERE SO BHD WE SENT Chow UP IN A JEEP ON THE 10Th WE MOVED OUT GOING THUR TOWNS THAT LOOKED LIKE AN KUMBER KARD, FIRD WRECKED GUNS, VERICLES AND EVERYThing ELSE LAYING ALL OVER THE PLACE. WE SET UP OUR KITCHEN IN PE SHED AND GOT US A NIES ROOM TO SLEEP IN. NE COOKED AND SENT IT UP IN A JEED SOMETIMES GETTING TO FEED AND OTHER TIMES HAVING TO THROW IT DOUT. WE WEKE THERE UNTIL VATTE THE 15th AND THEN WE MOYED AGAIN. WE SET UP THE KITCHEN IN WITH THE SUPPLY AND HAD TO SLEEP IN A HOR SHED ON RECOUNT OF THE TOWN WELL THE KNOCKED

DOWN. WE KEPT ON COOKING SENDING IT UP IN A TEED. ON THE 21 ST OF GRN WE MOVED OUT AND WENT to BASTONE, BELGIUM to OME OF HILTER'S MARRISON CAMPS. THERE WE SET UP to BE WITH THE COMPANY FOR a FEW DAYS. WE MOVED FROM THERE ON THE 29 AND NENT TO WEISWAMPACK, JUX, WHERE WE FED THE MEN CARRYING IT UP IN A JEEP AGAIN. ON THE 3rd of Feb. THE CO. PULLED BACK IN WEISWAMPACK AGAIN, ON THE 5TH WE MOVED WITH THE CO. AND WENT THUR ST-VITA WHERE YOU DIDN'T SEE ONE HOUSE STANDING. WE WENT ON TO EXCHERATE SER, ON THE LUX + SER BOYDER. WE SET THE KITCHEN UP IN A HOUSE WITH THE HITH - PLA. AND POOKED SUPPER THAT WIGHT. WE COOKED BREAKFAST BUT THE BO HAD TO LAT ON A RUN, FOR THEY HAD TO MOVED OUT. THAT WAS THE BEQINNING OF THE SIEGFRIED LINE AND WE LOST QUIET A-FEW MEN THERE, ON July 11 we moved out and had to set up in the woods. We cooked and sent it up on a greep until the 17th of Feb when we gulled back to Teidenborn with the Company. on the 21 st we moved back to the wood again to the SAME PLACE, on The 26 we MOVED OUT OF THE WOODS SEEING WREEK YEHICLES AND DEAD GERMANS. WE UNLOADED SO THE TRUEKS COULD go BACK AND MOVE THE FIELD TRAIN, WE HAD TO LOAD UP AGRIN THE SAME NIGHT AND WOVE WENT TO THE COMPANY, GETTING THERE JUST RS THEY WERE GOING TO MOVE OUT . ON FEU-28 WE MOVED OUT AND WENT to A HUNTING hodge WHERE THEY HAD THE 3rd BN. KITCHENS AND MOTOR POOL - WERE THERE UNTIL MARCH 3nd, WHEN WE MOVED OUT AT NIGHT

AND IT WERE SO DARK YOU COULDN'T SEE ANYThing ON THE WAY UP NI- CO. TRUCK TURNED OVER, WHEN WE got to the to. WE SET up to POOK BREAKFAST, ON THE MORNING OF THE 9th THE COMPANY MOVED US to CATCH ON WITH THE FIELD TRAIN. WE got to MAYEM WE HAD TO FINE SOME-WHERE TO SLEEP SO WE FOUND AN BOX-CAR WITH AN HEATER IN IT SO WE MADE OUR-SELVES AT HOME. WE FOUND CASES OF SODA - WATER IN THE BALLROAD - STATION. WE MORED OUT THE 10th AND WENT UP IN MAYEN WHERE THE CO. WERE. THERE WE SET UP IN 3 much BOOMS WHICH WE CLEANED OUT BY THROWING EVERY Thino OUT. This TOWAR WAS PHATTY WELL KNOCKED DOWN BY OUR PLANES. ON THE 12TH THE CO MOVED OUT LEAVING US UNTIL A TRUCK TOULD TOME AFTER US. WHILE WE WERE WAITING ON THE TRUCK WE WENT MOPE HOUSES to SEE WHAT WE POULD FINE. WE MOVED OUT ABOUT 5 hours LATER GOING TO WHERE THE PO HAD MOVED TO - SOUTTING OUT KITCHEN IN WITH THE ATA PLA. WE FED THE TROOPS UNTIL THE 17 Th. WHEN THEY JUINDED OFF TO CROSS THE MOSEL ROVER FOR THE SECOND TIME. THE 18Th MARCH WE WENT ACROSS THE MOSEL AND WENT TO ALKEN. THAT IS WHERE BREAUNT CAME BACK TO US. WE MOYED OUT ON THE 20th AND GOT TO THE CO THAT WIGHT BOOKING SUPPER THEOLING ABOUT 11:30 That NIGht. WE FED BREAKFAST THEN THEY MOVED OUT AGRIN RACEING FOR THE RHINE RIVER, JUE MOVED OUT FROM BINGER AND ON THUP PARTEN-HEIN AUD DO DONNED TO IM JAU-BISCHOFShoiN. STATION 23 Ad of MAREN THEK AT LEEDEIN.

WE COULD SEE GERMAN'S PLANES EVERY NIGHT TRYING to BOMB The BRIDGE ACRUSS THEY RHINE, ON MARE 26 & WENT ACROSS THE RHINE TO HELP LIND AS THE THOOPS WERE MOVING SO FAST THEY HAD TO KEEP THE TRUCKS GOING.
