- 2. The VII Corps will initiate its attack on CHERBOURG on 19 June with three (3) divisions abreast, in order from right to left, 4th,79th, and 9th.
 - a. Boundaries: See Annex No 1 Operations Overlay:
 - b. Time of attack: 4th Div = 190300. 79th Div = 190500. 9th Div = 190500.

3. a. 4TH DIVISION.

(1) Attachments.

183d FA Bn (155 How)
70th Tk Bn

(2) Will make its initial major effort up the QUINEVILLE ridge and seize the high ground in the vic of TATERVILLE - HAU DES TERRIERS, preparatory to a further advance on CHERBOURG.

b. 79TH DIVISION.

(1) Attachments.

951st FA Bn (155 How) Co B 801st TD Bn Cos A & B, 87th Cml Bn Co A 746th Tk Bn

- (2) Facsing through the 90th Inf Div, will make its main effort initially on its left. Will seize the high ground west and northwest of Valognes south of the R DE GLOIRE preparatory to further advance on CHERBOURG.
- (3) The attack of the 79th Div will be supported initially by two light artillery battalions of the 90th Div in addition to 79th Div Arty.

c. 9TH DIVISION.

(1) Attachments.

188th FA Gp 957th FA Bn (155 How) 172d FA Bn (4.5 Gun) 746th Tk Bn (less Co A) 899th TD Bn (less 2 Cos)

(2) Will attack to the north and seize the general line REUVILLE LA BIGOT (0910) - CROSVILLE (0409) - ST GERMAIN LE GAILLARD (0106) preparatory to a further advance on CHERBOURG.

(3): The 47th Inf will be relieved by one RCT (reinforced by 1 Bn Medium Warty) of the 90th Div as soon as practicable 18 June.

Rd. 90TH DIVISION.

- (1) Attachments.
- Co B 899th TD Bn
- (2) Will send one RCT reinforced with a battalion of medium artillery to relieve the 47th Inf in the area ST LO D'OUTVILLE NEUVILLE EN BEAUMONT (1390) LE ROU UERAY (1394) (Hill #110) LE MESNIL ST MARTAIN (0793). This RCT will prevent any enemy advance to the north between ST SAUVEUR DU PIERRE PUNT (1488) FORT BAIL (0689).
 - (3) \The remainder of the 90th Div, when passed through by the 79th Div, will assemble in Corps Reserve in the area ORGLANDES BINIVILLE (at 217978) REIGNEVILLE.
 - (4) Two light artillery battalions of the 90th Div will initially support the attack of the 79th Div.

e. 82D AIRBORNE DIVISION.

(1) Attachments.

87th Armd FA Bn 188th FA Bn (155 How) Co C 899th TD Bn Tp B 4th Cav Ren Sq

- (2) Will retain its bridgehead southwest of ST SAUVEUR LE VICOMTE until passed through by the 357th Inf. Thereafter, the boundary between the 82d Div and the 357th Inf, 9Cth Div, will extend along the railroad line between ST SAUVEUR LE VICOMTE and ST SAUVEUR DU PIERRE-PONT, all to 357th Inf.
- (3) Early 19 June the division will seize a bridgehead beyond the DCHVE FIVER south of FONT L'ABBE, east of the BOIS DE LIMORS, and connect this bridgehead with the existing bridgehead south of BENZEVILLE LA BASTILLE.
- (4) It will extend patrols to the FORET DE PONT CASTRE and LA HAYE DU PUITS.
- f: 4TH CAVALRY GROUP. (less 24th Cav Sq and Tp B, 4th Cav Sq) will reconnoiter in area indicated in Overlay and maintain contact between the 79th and 9th Divisions.
- g. <u>VII CORPS ARTILLERY</u>. Bulk of fires of VII Corps Artillery will be north of the line ST GERMAIN DE TOURNEBUT (3010) VALOGNES BRICQUEBEC. Fires south of that line will be only on call of the divisions.
 - x. (1) Bomblines effective 190500.
 - (a) North Bombline ST VAAST QUETTEHOU THEURTEVILLE BOCAGE (3017) VAUTIERS (2215) RR crossing at (103138) BRIC WEBES LES PIEUX SCIOTOT (973087). No bombing South of this line.
 - (b) South Bombline River mouth at (090840) MOULINERIE (143850) LA HAYE DU PUITS RJ at (267855) LA BUTTE (275836.) No bombing North of this line.

(2) White smoke will be used by units requesting special air support missions within the bombline to mark targets. (No red smoke is at present available).
