Dear 90th Members,





Many of you already know that on May 9, 2016,

my beloved husband of 25 years, went Home to Heaven, leaving me broken-hearted. He SO wanted to be at the Reunion this year - and in 2017 & 2018. Alas, it was not to be. My comfort is in knowing that because he had accepted Jesus Christ as his Savior, he is with Jesus - whole again - no pain - no physical limitations anymore. I miss him terribly - he was the light and love of my life. He had struggled physically the last few years, but was alert and engaged in life's daily activities. An emergency trip to the hospital on February 20 changed everything, when the doctors told us he had fluid around his left lung that was pressing into the lung and had partially collapsed it. He also had aspiration pneumonia, a temp of 102 and a left lung that was full of aspirated food particles. It took 4 days to drain the fluid from around the lung, and we were told it would probably return at some point. If it did, they would not drain a 2nd time, due to his age. Our options were a feeding tube or a pureed diet and palliative care [the step prior to hospice]. The doctor's prognosis was that he had 6-9 months. I was devastated. They did send him to rehab, but after 7 weeks, I was told Medicare would not pay for any more because he had plateaued and was not improving. As I began to ready the house for his return home, I was advised to call in hospice who told me it was an unwise decision to bring him home because I could not possibly take care of him. In order for him to receive the full VA benefits due him, he had to be in a facility that had a contract with the VA. In all of Chicago area, there was only 1 that was a reasonable distance from our home. It broke both our hearts for him to be there, because there was virtually no opportunity for social interaction. I prayed hard that God would not let him suffer or be there for any length of time. He answered my prayer in that he was there only 2 weeks. The end came so quickly - OK through Friday afternoon, May 7 - home in Heaven at 2:15 a.m. May 9 - He was 91 and 4 months to the day. His Celebration of Life service was at our church on June 7 - 71 years to the day that he landed on Utah Beach, and 1 year exactly when he was awarded the French Legion of Honor Medal. I was honored and humbled that there were 10 members from the 90th Family who came for his service - it was a beautiful service! You need to know that through this journey, God blessed me every day with assurances of His presence and love for us both - too many things to detail here. Does my heart hurt? You bet! Do I cry a lot? Yup - every day.- the "new normal", I've been told. BUT God is good and will continue to guide my life each day - I couldn't get through this without that.

Now - about the Reunion - BRING YOUR LANYARDS! if you have any at home. For all: PAY THOSE DUES! Less than 400 paid last year - a dismal number. - God willing, I will be at the reunion.
