I. AMENDMENT OF GENERAL ORDERS NUMBER 89: So much of Section IV General Orders Number 89, this headquarters, current series, as awards a Bronze Star posthumously to MARK E. MONAGHAN, 6904263, Technician Fifth Grade, Infantry, United States Army, is rescinded and the following substituted therefor:

AWARD, POSTHUMOUS, OF BRONZE STAR: Under the provisions of AR 600-45 and Section I Circular 6, Third United States Army, current series, the Bronze Star is awarded posthumously to:

MARK E. MONAGHAN, 6904263, Technician Fifth Grade, Medical Department, United States Army, for heroic service in connection with military operations against the enemy in France during the period 11 - 13 June 1944. Entered Military Service from Missouri.

II. AWARD OF OAK-LEAF CLUSTER: Under the provisions of AR 600-45 and Section I Circular 6, Third United States Army, current series, in addition to the Bronze Star previously awarded, a Bronze Oak-Leaf Cluster is awarded to:

WILLIAM A. BERNDT, 01323901, First Lieutenant (then Second Lieutenant), Infantry, United States Army, for heroic achievement in connection with military operations against the enemy in France on 7 September 1944. Entered Military Service from Kansas.

III. AWARD OF BRONZE STAR: Under the provisions of AR 600-45 and Section I Circular 6, Third United States Army, current series, the Bronze Star is awarded to:

ZBIGNIEW WILK, 6146225, First Sergeant, Infantry, United States Army, for heroic achievement in connection with military operations against the enemy in France on 6 August 1944. Entered Military Service from Massachusetts.
