Under the provisions of AR 600-45 and Section I Circular 6, Third United States Army, current series, the Bronze Star is awarded to:

JOSEPH MEROE, 0467582, Captain, Medical Corps, United States Army, for meritorious service in connection with military operations against the enemy in France during the period 8 June to 24 September 1944. Entered Military Service from Wisconsin.

EDWARD L. ROSE, 0408468, Captain, Infantry, United States Army, for heroic achievement in connection with military operations against the enemy in France on 17 August 1944. Entered Military Service from North Carolina.

ZACHARY A. BALIAN, 01306534, First Lieutenant, Infantry, United States Army, for heroic achievement in connection with military operations against the enemy in France on 17 August 1944. Entered Military Service from California.

WILFRED GLAZER, 01320037, First Lieutenant (then Second Lieutenant), Infantry, United States Army, for meritorious service in connection with military operations against the enemy in France during the period 8 June to 24 September 1944. Entered Military Service from New Jersey.

HOMER W. GRAY, 37179016, First Sergeant, Infantry, United States Army, for heroic achievement in connection with military operations against the enemy in France, on 10 July 1944. Entered Military Service from Missouri.

CAYROL L. KNIZLEY, 6930990, Technical Sergeant, Infantry, United States Army, for heroic achievement in connection with military operations against the enemy in France on 4 July 1944. Entered Military Service from Colorado.

JOSEPH W. STOBBE, 39919784, Staff Sergeant, Infantry, United States Army, for heroic achievement in connection with military operations against the enemy in France on 15 and 16 September 1944. Entered Military Service from Utah.
