AWARD OF BRONZE STAR

Under the provisions of AR 600-45 and Section I, Circular 6, Third United States Army, current series, the Bronze Star is awarded to:

THORN O. MCGEE, 39017528, Corporal (then Technician Fifth Grade) Field Artillery, United States Army, for heroic achievement in connection with military operations against the enemy in France on 9 July 1944. Entered Military Service from California.

THOMAS J. NIPPS, 35766920, Private First Class (then Private) Field Artillery, United States Army, for heroic achievement in connection with military operations against the enemy in France on 16 September 1944. Entered Military Service from West Virginia.

JAMES TATE, 16142912, Private, Field Artillery, United States Army, for heroic achievement in connection with military operations against the enemy in France on 16 September 1944. Entered Military Service from Illinois.
