II. AWARD OF BRONZE STAR: Under the provisions of AR 600-45 and Section I Circular 6, Third United States Army, current series, the Bronze Star is awarded to:

CLEON E. GLINES, 37683563, Sergeant, Infantry, United States Army, for heroic achievement in connection with military operations against the enemy in France on 12 September 1944. Entered Military Service from Iowa.

EDWARD L. MADDEN, 31190394, Technician Fifth Grade, Medical Department, United States Army, for heroic achievement in connection with military operations against the enemy in France on 4 September 1944. Entered Military Service from Connecticut.

CHARLEY C. PAULSON, 37172044, Technician Fifth Grade, Infantry, United States Army, for heroic service in connection with military operations against the enemy in France during the period 8 June to 17 August 1944. Entered Military Service from Minnesota.

RAYMOND J. SCHAEFER, 35810700, Private First Class, Infantry, United States Army, for heroic achievement in connection with military operations against the enemy in France on 8 September 1944. Entered Military Service from Illinois.
