JAKE R. PARTON, 37189194, Staff Sergeant, Infantry, United States Army, for heroic achievement in connection with military operations against the enemy in France on 7 August 1944. Entered Military Service from Iowa.

II--Award of Oak-Leaf Cluster to Bronze Star--Under the provisions of Army Regulation 600-45 and Section I Circular 6, Third United States Army, 26 April 1944, in addition to the Bronze Star previously awarded an Oak-Leaf Cluster is awarded to:

OSCAR N. HOFFMAN, JR., 0887615, First Lieutenant, Infantry, United States Army, for heroic achievement in connection with military operations against the enemy in France on 15 October 1944. Entered Military Service from New York.

III--Award of Bronze Star--Under the provisions of Army Regulation 600-45 and Section I Circular 6, Third United States Army, 26 April 1944, the Bronze Star is awarded to:

RALPH B. MERRICK, 0391391, Captain, Infantry, United States Army, for heroic achievement in connection with military operations against the enemy in France on 15 October 1944. Entered Military Service from Ohio.

ELMER D. QUERAM, 01318467, First Lieutenant, Infantry, United States Army, for heroic achievement in connection with military operations against the enemy in France on 24 June 1944. Entered Military Service from Wisconsin.

EDWARD R. BODDY, 39087677, Sergeant, Infantry, United States Army, for heroic achievement in connection with military operations against the enemy in France on 7 July 1944. Entered Military Service from California.

ROY A. LENNOX, 35236231, Private, Infantry, United States Army, (Now Missing in Action), for heroic achievement in connection with military operations against the enemy in France on 6 July 1944. Entered Military Service from Ohio.


