I-- Award, Posthumous, of Silver Star--Under the provisions of Army Regulation 600-45 and Section I, Circular 6, Third United States Army, 26 April 1944, the Silver Star is awarded posthumously to:

ROBERT W. KVENMOEN, 37172119, Staff Sergeant, Infantry, United States Army, for gallantry in action in France on 8 September 1944. Entered Military Service from North Dakota.

II-- Award of Bronze Star--Under the provisions of Army Regulation 600-45 and Section I, Circular 6, Third United States Army, 26 April 1944, the Bronze Star is awarded to:

JACOB W. BRAKKE, JR., 0305676, Lieutenant Colonel, Infantry, United States Army, for heroic service in connection with military operations against the enemy in France during the period 8 June to 24 October 1944. Entered Military Service from Missouri.

CLEVELAND A. LYTTLE, 0326170, Lieutenant Colonel (Then Major), Infantry, United States Army, for heroic service in connection with military operations against the enemy in France during the period 5 August to 24 October 1944. Entered Military Service from Pennsylvania.
