I--Award of Oak-Leaf Cluster to Silver Star--Under the provisions of Army Regulation 600-45 and Section I, Circular 6, Third United States Army, 26 April 1944, in addition to the Silver Star previously awarded, an Oak-Leaf Cluster is awarded to:

GEORGE L. MILLS, 35699484, Sergeant, Infantry, United States Army, for gallantry in action in France on 21 August 1944. Entered Military Service from Indiana.

HENRY BRAUN, 32413396, Private, Infantry, United States Army, for gallantry in action in France on 21 August 1944. Entered Military Service from New York.

II--Award, Posthumous, of Silver Star--Under the provisions of Army Regulation 600-45 and Section I, Circular 6, Third United States Army, 26 April 1944, the Silver Star is awarded posthumously to:

LEONARD C. DULL, 0313564, Major, Infantry, United States Army, for gallantry in action in France on 15 September 1944. Entered Military Service from Nebraska.
