EDWARD L. MARKS, 01318915, Second Lieutenant, Infantry, United States Army, for gallantry in action in France on 18 August 1944. Entered Military Service from New York.

JOHN B. GARNER, 38147198, Private First Class, Infantry, United States Army, for gallantry in action in France on 3 July 1944. Entered Military Service from Texas.

ALBERT J. ZANCA, 32956231, Private First Class, Infantry, United States Army, for gallantry in action in France on 3 July 1944. Entered Military Service from New Jersey.

II--Award of Bronze Star--Under the provisions of Army Regulation 600-45 and Section I, Circular 6, Third United States Army, 26 April 1944, the Bronze Star is awarded to:

LAWRENCE G. KAPLAN, 0337807, Captain, Medical Corps, United States Army, for heroic service in connection with military operations against the enemy in France during the period 10 July to 24 September 1944. Entered Military Service from New York.

HAYWOOD M. OREY, 38094057, Technician Fifth Grade, Infantry, United States Army, for heroic service in connection with military operations against the enemy in France during the period 15 - 17 September 1944. Entered Military Service from Texas.
