AWARD OF PURPLE HEART

1. Under the provisions of AM 600-45 as amended and paragraph 5 FUSA Circular No. 66, 18 May 1944, authority to award the Purple Heart is delegated to regimental and separate unit commanders. Awards to personnel of Special Troops 90th Inf Div and 90th Recn Tr Bde will be published by this Hq.

2. In addition to unit distribution, three copies of unit General Orders announcing awards will be provided for The Adjutant General, Attention: Decorations and Awards Branch, Munitions Bldg, Washington 25, D. C.; two copies for CG, ETOUSA and one copy for CG, FUSA, attention G-1, Misc Sec, APO 230.

3. The above will be included in distribution listed but will be furnished this Hq promptly for disposition. Two copies will be furnished this Hq (for file and Div PRO).

4. Attention is called to the necessity for prompt publication of awards; and the fact that the Oak Leaf Cluster is awarded for wounds received after initial award of the Purple Heart.
