EARL G. KROOK, 36876585, Corporal, Corps of Engineers, United States Army, for heroic achievement in connection with military operations against the enemy in France on 30 October 1944. Entered Military Service from Michigan.

WILLIAM L. ADAMS, 38093977, Private, Corps of Engineers, United States Army, for heroic achievement in connection with military operations against the enemy in France on 9 November 1944. Entered Military Service from Texas.
