JAMES G. LAMBERT, 37153707, Staff Sergeant, Infantry, United States Army, for gallantry in action in France during the period 4 - 11 September 1944. Entered Military Service from Kansas.

LOREN L. LINDQUIST, 37173085, Corporal, Infantry, United States Army, for gallantry in action in France on 9 November 1944. Entered Military Service from Minnesota.

HERBERT T. WITMER, JR., 33508736, Private First Class, Infantry, United States Army, for gallantry in action in France on 12 November 1944. Entered Military Service from Pennsylvania.

FLOYD D. BUSH, 38094937, Private First Class, Infantry, United States Army, for heroic achievement in connection with military operations against the enemy in France on 16 November 1944. Entered Military Service from Texas.

ARNOLD V. HALL, 37171268, Private First Class, Infantry, United States Army, for heroic achievement in connection with military operations against the enemy in France on 16 November 1944. Entered Military Service from Minnesota.

JAMES G. WALTERS, 34872750, Private First Class, Infantry, United States Army, for heroic achievement in connection with military operations against the enemy in France on 19 August 1944. Entered Military Service from Mississippi.
