
UNIFORM REGULATIONS

1. The steel helmet will be worn at all times except when in shelter.
2. Arms, cartridge belts and ammunition will be carried outside of bivouac areas. Belts will be worn over the outside garment.
3. Officers under arms will wear the belt with shoulder straps.
4. Leggins or regulation boots are prescribed uniform.
5. Unit commanders and chiefs of staff sections will see that their officers and men are reasonably clean and freshly shaven. Those having to shave daily will do so as soon after arising in the morning as conditions permit. Commanders of front line units will use favorable opportunities to have men clean up and shave.
