AWARD OF OAK-LEAF CLUSTER: Under the provisions of AR 600-45 and Circular 6, Third United States Army, current series, in addition to the Silver Star previously awarded, a Bronze Oak-Leaf Cluster is awarded to:

JACOB W. BEALKE, JR, 0305676, Lieutenant Colonel, Infantry, United States Army, for gallantry in action in France on 19 August 1944. Entered Military Service from Missouri.

II. AWARD OF SILVER STAR: Under the provisions of AR 600-45 and Circular 6, Third United States Army, current series, the Silver Star is awarded to:

JOHN D. FOSTER, 34456818, Private, Corps of Engineers, United States Army, for gallantry in action in France on 9 August 1944. Entered Military Service from North Carolina.

III. AWARD OF BRONZE STAR: Under the provisions of AR 600-45 and Circular 6, Third United States Army, current series, the Bronze Star is awarded to:

OLIVER H. McDANIEL, 0292637, Major, Infantry, United States Army, for meritorious achievement in connection with military operations against the enemy in France during the period 6 June 1944 to 2 September 1944. Entered Military Service from South Carolina.

JAMES W. ROSE, 38093999, Technical Sergeant, (then Staff Sergeant) Field Artillery, United States Army, for meritorious achievement in connection with military operations against the enemy in France during the period 15 - 21 August 1944. Entered Military Service from Texas.

CLIFFORD W. HAND, 39383246, Staff Sergeant, (then Technician Fourth Grade) Field Artillery, United States Army, for meritorious achievement in connection with military operations against the enemy in France during the period 15 - 21 August 1944. Entered Military Service from Washington.

EDWIN A. ERICKSON, 37171155, Technician Fourth Grade, Field Artillery, United States Army, for meritorious achievement in connection with military operations against the enemy in France during the period 15 - 21 August 1944. Entered Military Service from North Dakota.

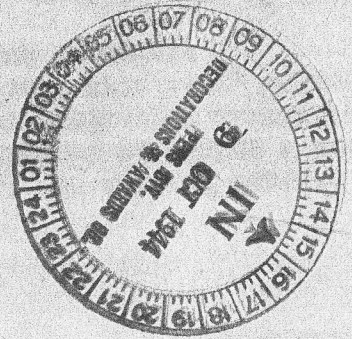
