ALBERT M. VINES, 33042747, Private First Class, Infantry, United States Army, for gallantry in action in France on 16 August 1944. Entered Military Service from Virginia.

II. AMENDMENT OF GENERAL ORDERS NUMBER 74: So much of Section IV General Orders 74, this headquarters, current series, as awards a Bronze Star to RICHARD K. ELWELL, 01325484, First Lieutenant, Infantry, United States Army, is rescinded and the following substituted therefor:

AWARD OF OAK-LEAF CLUSTER: Under the provisions of AR 600-45 and Circular 6, Third United States Army, current series, in addition to the Bronze Star previously awarded, a Bronze Oak-Leaf Cluster is awarded to:

RICHARD K. ELWELL, 01325484, First Lieutenant, Infantry, United States Army, for heroic service in connection with military operations against the enemy in France on 14 June 1944. Entered Military Service from Ohio.

III. AWARD OF PURPLE HEART: Under the provisions of AR 600-45 dated 22 September 1943, the Purple Heart is awarded to:

EDWARD W. SONNENBERG, 37166576, Private First Class, Infantry, United States Army, for wounds received in action against the enemy in France on 6 August 1944. Entered Military Service from Minnesota.
