SECT. I VENEREAL DISEASE

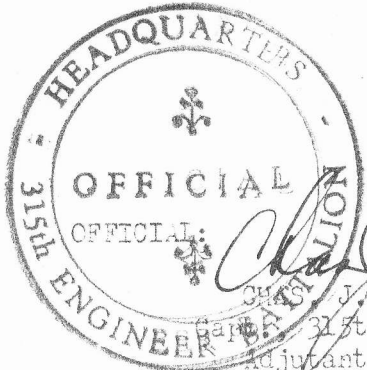
1. "x x x Any individual who knows he has contracted or has reason to believe he may have contracted a venereal disease will report the fact to his immediate commanding officer without unnecessary delay in order that proper medical treatment may be given. Trial by court martial or other disciplinary action for failure so to report is discretionary with the commanding officer". (Section II, WD Circular No. 14, 1940)
2. Under the authority of the above quoted circular, individuals who fail to report the full facts to their company or detachment commanders immediately, will be punished by court martial.

SECT. II INTOXICATING LIQUOR

1. Soldiers under the influence of intoxicating liquor after duty hours, but not disorderly will be assisted to their quarters.
2. Soldiers under the influence of intoxicating liquor on duty or in a public place in such a manner as to reflect discredit upon the military service will be brought to trial by court martial.
