I--AWARD OF 2ND OAK LEAF CLUSTER TO PURPLE HEART--. Under the provisions of AR 600-45, dated 22 Sept. 1943, as amended, in addition to the Purple Heart and one Bronze Oak-Leaf Cluster previously awarded, a second Bronze Oak-Leaf Cluster is awarded to:-

SGT JOSEPH W. COPELAND, 6230964, for wounds received in action against the enemy in Germany on 15 December 1944. Entered the Military Service from New Mexico

SGT DONALD R. HALE, 37491812, for wounds received in action against the enemy in Belgium on 30 January 1945. Entered the Military Service from Kansas.

II--REVOCATION IN GENERAL ORDERS NUMBER 4, 1945--Paragraph 4, General Orders Number 4, this Headquarters, dated 10 May 1945, awarding the Purple Heart to Pfc. Gilbert L. Catlett, 35498365, for wounds received on 15 March 1945, is revoked. This award is republished in Section III of this General Orders.


