AWARD OF OAK LEAF CLUSTER TO PURPLE HEART

1. Under the provisions of AR 600-45, dated 22 Sept 1943, as amended, in addition to the Purple Heart previously awarded a Bronze Oak Leaf Cluster is awarded to Cpl Glen H. Elletson, 37 444 467, for wounds received in action against the enemy in Germany on 11 December 1944. Entered the Military Service from Minnesota.
