I. AWARD OF THE PURPLE HEART By direction of the President and authority contained in AR 600-45, 22 September 1943, as amended, The Purple Heart is awarded to the following named Officer, United States Army, for wounds received in action against the enemy in France:

FIRST LIEUTENANT JOSEPH R. DURBIN, O-1292849, Infantry; wounded on 21 September 1944. Entered military service from Pennsylvania.

II.
