RGO No 1, 10 July 43, is rescinded. The following duties will be performed by the personnel of the guard in addition to those prescribed in TM 26-5.

1. OFFICER OF THE DAY

<u>a.</u> The Officer of the Day will take reveille and retreat reports from the respective Bn Duty Officers and Special Unit Officers, except when the alert guard is in force. These reports will be taken from a post at the junction of the Fire Break and a Samden Avenue. Reports will be given to the OD not later than firteen (15) minutes after reveille and retreat respectively.

b. The Officer of the Day will perform his regular duties during drill hours in addition to his duties as

officer of the day, except,

(1) Then alert guard is in force, or

(2) Then his regular duties take him from the

post, in which case S-1 will be notified in advance.

2. CONTIANDER OF THE GUARD

Will carefully instruct his guard:

As to the location of Tire alarm boxes and the method of giving the fire alarm, and the proper method of using fire extinguishers.

 b. As to all pertinent Post Regulations.
 c. That civilians will not be permitted in the except on streets and in buildings open to the regimental area, except on streets and in buildings open to the public, unless they have a written pass from RHC. Friends will be

permitted to visit enlisted men in the company day rooms, but will not be allowed to enter barracks except in company of an officer.

d. That civilians will not be arrested, but if a ivilian is guilty of any offense in violation of his Special Orders, e will be detained and the OD will notify the Provost Marshal

immediately. e. The Commander of the Guard will not accept prisoners for confinement, unless accompanied by a Written statement of an Officer covering the prisoner's name, grade, serial number, organization, Article of War violated and a brief description of the

offense.
