RGO No 1, 10 July 43, is rescinded. The following duties will be performed by the personnel of the guard in addition to those prescribed in FM 26-5.

1. OFFICER OF THE DAY

a. The Officer of the Day will take reveille and retreat reports from the respective Bn Duty Officers and Special Unit Officers, except when the alert guard is in force. These reports will be taken from a post at the junction of the Fire Break and Camden Avenue. Reports will be given to the OD not later than fifteen (15) minutes after reveille and retreat respectively.

b. The Officer of the Day will perform his regular duties during drill hours in addition to his duties as officer of the day, except,
 (1) When alert guard is in force, or
 (2) When his regular duties take him from the post, in which case S-1 will be notified in advance.

2. COMMANDER OF THE GUARD

Will carefully instruct his guard:

a. As to the location of Fire alarm boxes and the method of giving the fire alarm, and the proper method of using fire extinguishers.

b. As to all pertinent Post Regulations.

c. That civilians will not be permitted in the regimental area, except on streets and in buildings open to the public, unless they have a written pass from RHC. Friends will be permitted to visit enlisted men in the company day rooms, but will not be allowed to enter barracks except in company of an officer.

d. That civilians will not be arrested, but if a civilian is guilty of any offense in violation of his Special Orders, he will be detained and the OD will notify the Provost Marshal immediately.

e. The Commander of the Guard will not accept prisoners for confinement, unless accompanied by a written statement of an Officer covering the prisoner's name, grade, serial number, organization, Article of War violated and a brief description of the offense.

3. REGULAR GUARD POSTS (See Annex No. 1)

- Post No. 1. Daily from 1700 to 1700.
- Post No. 2. Daily from 1700 to 0700.
- Post No. 3. Daily from 1700 to 0700. Saturday from 1200; Sunday and Holidays 24 hrs.
- Post No. 4. Daily from 1700 to 0700.
- Post No. 5. Daily from 1700 to 0700.
- Post No. 6. Daily from 1700 to 0700. (Same as 3)
- Post No. 7. Daily from 1730 to 2200.

4. SPECIAL ORDERS

- a. Post No. 1 - to allow no prisoners to leave the area except under appropriate authority and under adequate guard.
- b. Post No. 3 - To allow no vehicles to be removed from the Motor Pool except through the main entrance to the pool.
 - (2) To allow no loitering.
 - (3) To check all vehicles to see that the keys are in the switches.

(4) To allow no one to remove any vehicle from the Motor Pool without a proper trip ticket.

(5) In case of fire, to notify the Commander of the Guard immediately and to attempt to extinguish the fire.

c. Posts No. 2, 4, 5, 6

(1) In case of fire to awaken the occupants of the buildings, then proceed to nearest fire alarm box to give the alarm.

(2) Sentry on Post No. 6 will try the doors on the TSO each time around after duty hours of TSO personnel and allow no one except authorized personnel to remove any property.

d. Post No. 7

(1) To allow no one to take paper cups or bottles outside of PX.

(2) To allow no one to throw refuse on the floor.

(3) To allow no unsoldierly conduct.

(4) To allow no one to enter the PX unless in proper uniform.
