2. COINANDER OF THE GUARD will carefully instruct his guard:
a. As to the location of Fire Alarm boxes and the method of giving the fire alarm, and the proper method of using fire extinguishers.

d. That civilians will not be arrested, but if a civilian is guilty of any offense in violation of his Special Orders, he will be detained and the OD will notify the Provost Marshal imm-
