Gangloff, 33404911, for wounds received in action against the enemy in France on 16 September 1944. Entered Military Service from Pennsylvania. ✓

MOODY-PEMBERTON

Under the provisions of AR 600-45, dated 22 September 1943, and in addition to the Purple Heart previously awarded him, a Bronze Oak Leaf Cluster is awarded to Pvt Pemberton Moody, 36068600, for wounds received in action against the enemy in France on 15 September 1944. Entered Military Service from Illinois. ✓

Under the provisions of AR 600-45, dated 22 September 1943, and in addition to the Purple Heart previously awarded him, a Bronze Oak Leaf Cluster is awarded to Pvt John M. Williams, 35227238, for wounds received in action against the enemy in France on 16 September 1944. Entered Military Service from Indiana. ✓
