II. AWARD OF THE PURPLE HEART OAK LEAF CLUSTER.

Under the provisions of AR 600-45, dated 22 September 1943, and in addition to the Purple Heart previously awarded him, a Bronze Oak Leaf Cluster is awarded to Cpl Joseph V Revell, 38 352 000, for wounds received in action against the enemy in France on 20 September 1944. Entered Military Service from New Mexico.

Under the provisions of AR 600-45, dated 22 September 1943, and in addition to the Purple Heart previously awarded him, a Bronze Oak Leaf Cluster is awarded to Pfc Nicholas S Gangloff, 33 404 911, for wounds received in action against the enemy in France on August 19, 1944. Entered Military Service from Pennsylvania.
