Under the provisions of AR 600-45, dated 22 September 1943, and in addition to The Purple Heart previously awarded him, a Bronze Oak Leaf Cluster is awarded to Pvt Herman Bogaty, 37721138, Infantry, for wounds received in action against the Co L enemy in France on 2 October 1944. Entered Military Service from Nevada.

Under the provisions of AR 600-45, dated 22 September 1943, and in addition to The Purple Heart previously awarded him, a Bronze Oak Leaf Cluster is awarded to Pvt Lloyd G. Stanley, 38125197, Infantry, for wounds received in action against Co M the enemy in France on 29 September 1944. Entered Military Service from Texas.
